The Trestle Dashboard now supports SAML-based single sign-on. An MLO, Technology Provider, or Broker account can have their own Identity Provider (IdP) configured for use with Trestle.

Organizations with their own IdP should reach out to Trestle support (either your support rep, or by email or Slack) to begin the conversation. Trestle currently has plug-and-play support for CoreLogic Clareity, and we're ready to do the work to adapt to any other IdP that might speak slightly different SAML idioms.

The login page now loads with just the username. Enter that and click "next" (or hit return). If your account belongs to an organization configured to use Single Sign-On, you'll be redirected to your Identity Provider for authentication. If not, a password field will appear, and you can log in normally. This is the same SSO login flow used by Slack and Microsoft Office, among others.

The Trestle Dashboard will not auto-provision accounts for new users it sees coming in from single sign-on. Account Admins will need to create Trestle login accounts for every user they want to enable for access (inside Account > User Manager). Trestle usernames are email addresses, and they will need to match the email of the SSO user. As a result, generic "bucket" email addresses like "idx@vendor.com" likely won't work for SSO.

Trestle Broker accounts can authenticate with either their own IdP if they have one, or their MLS's. This enables an MLS to put a link to Trestle onto their Clareity dashboard, for instance. MLS staff and Brokers will be able to access Trestle inside the same sign-on environment as all their other MLS-provided tools. Contact your Trestle account reps to get this all set up.

MLO: "Contractless" Connections to Broker Accounts

Trestle's "Contractless" Connection feature enables the MLO to make a data connection with a data consumer and skip the contracting and online license fee billing part of the process. This is useful for one-off data connections where the contracting and billing are special in some way, allowing those things to be handled offline and just using Trestle for the data. (We put the word "Contractless" in quotes here because there always *should* be a contract involved, it just doesn't get handled inside Trestle.)

This feature has been available for connections to TP accounts for over a year. Today's release adds the ability for MLO accounts to add "Contractless" Connections to Broker accounts. As with TPs, all Trestle fees still apply, but Trestle will not bill any MLO licensing fees for these data connections.

Inside the "Add Connection" dialog, the first field now lists all Technology Providers with fully activated accounts, *plus all Broker accounts that have connected to your market*.

We've changed the RE-SEND button in Contract lists from blue to yellow.

This adds some rhythm to the controls on that page, visually differentiates RE-SEND from VIEW CONTRACT, and echoes the yellow of icon used for In-Progress contracts on the dashboard front page.
